<u>Important Information about financial support for the Design Institutes</u>

To allow us to maximize the number of participants we can support, ISEE does not pay for accommodations and ground transportation for participants to attend the Design Institutes.

Participants traveling to a Design Institute: We ask that you find cost effective ways to attend the Design Institute, such as:

- Finding a reasonable hotel room and sharing it with another participant.
- Staying at a local participant's home.
- Sharing ground transportation (4 people in a rental car saves a lot).
- Finding a funding source to pay for accommodations and ground transportation (perhaps your institution or advisor is willing to pitch in a few hundred dollars).

Local participants: Those of you that live at a site where we hold Design Institutes can help out-of-town PDP participants by **considering yourself a host**, and:

- Offering a ride to and from the airport.
- Suggesting reasonable hotels and ground transportation options.
- Inviting a PDP participant to stay in an extra room or even on a couch.
- Offering to give rides from hotels to the Design Institute site, so that participants don't need rental cars.

However, all that said, we do not want to make participation a problem for anyone, and understand that in some cases participants will need financial assistance to attend the Design Institute. If you anticipate incurring costs for accommodations and/or ground transportation that would prevent you from being able to participate, please request financial assistance from ISEE.
